

Kaw Valley USBC - Bowler of the Year

The Kaw Valley USBC Bowler of the Year encompasses an individual who excels at and promotes the sport of bowling and Kaw Valley USBC. They will be determined by the point system outlined below. Bowler of the year winners comprise one male and one female from the following categories: Youth, Adult, Senior, and Super senior. Seniors are 50 to 64 years old and super seniors are 65 or older as of August 1 of the applicable bowling season.

Bowler must have an established average from a sanctioned Kaw Valley USBC league. If the bowler is in more than one league, their composite average will be used. Final average sheets received by the Kaw Valley Association Manager after May 5 of the applicable bowling season may not be accepted. Travel leagues are excluded.
